This coming Wednesday, a Senate committee will hold hearings on <u>SB 732</u>. This bill would give developers carte-blanche to clear-cut most of the remaining undeveloped land in Bexar County. The House version, <u>HB 1388</u>, has already passed out of committee with a vote of 3-2 favoring the bill.

I urge you to do everything you can to **kill this bill**. It is being pushed by powerful San Antonio developers and their well-funded lobbying groups.

The potential effects of this bill are:

- massive clear cutting of trees and stripping of hills,
- contamination of the Edwards Aquifer, our drinking water source,.
- more air pollution,
- increased stormwater runoff and flooding, and
- destruction of endangered species.
