

Dear GEAA members and friends,

Thanks so much to all of you who contacted the San Antonio City Council regarding water supply impact fees! On May 29th they voted 8-2 to charge the full amount allowed by State Law on new developments. We will continue to work hard to make sure that our government agencies and utilities do not continue to subsidize sprawl and growth over the Edwards Aquifer watershed.

Talks are still continuing about purchasing the land next to the Bracken Bat Preserve. In this case, no news is good news. We will keep you posted.

As for other news, not so good. Projects to develop on the Recharge Zone and in the Hill Country, which dropped off in 2008, are now being financed and they are revving up the bulldozers. I am getting about 2 - 3 notices a week about projects that are not at all appropriate if we are to protect our Edwards and Trinity water resources. If anyone wants to join the GEAA Technical Team and help out with our efforts to address these bad projects on a case by case basis, let me know.
