Great news! <u>H.B. 3036</u>, which would prohibit direct discharge of sewage effluent into waterways that recharge the Edwards Aquifer, is scheduled for a full vote by the Texas House on Tuesday, May 8th. I am told that the vote could come up as early as Monday. So, we definitely have an opportunity to get this legislation passed this session.

Thanks to all of you who already made calls and signed <u>the petition</u>. You have helped us get this far – which is pretty amazing! We need this one final push to win.

We are asking you to contact your State Representatives and State Senator to ask them to support HB 3036. Here are <u>talking points</u> you can use but, a <u>simple request for support is all that is needed</u>. For contact information click <u>here</u>.
