I don't usually send out two legislative alerts in one day but, it has come to my attention that On Tuesday, May 7th, the [House Committee on Land & Resource Management](#) will [hold a public hearing on SB 422](#).

[Senator Campbell's Senate Bill 422](#) would gut protections for trees on 27,000 acres currently protected by San Antonio's tree protection ordinance. Some of you may be constituents of committee members [Representative Ina Minjarez](#) or [Representative Kyle Biedermann](#). Please ask them to **vote no on SB 422**. Representative Minjarez's number is (512) 463-0634 and Representative Biedermann's is (512) 463-0325.

If you contact Representative Biedermann, you might also want to thank him for his excellent amendment to [HB 1806](#), which enables Kendall County Commissioners to control density and growth by requiring SAWS to obtain their consent prior to contracting for sale of water in Kendall County to exceed 1,500 acre feet of water per year.

A big thanks also goes out to all of you who are engaging with your legislators during this time when it really makes a difference.
