Thank you for your comments submitted on behalf of the Bulverde Neighborhood Alliance. A copy of your comments will be forwarded to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) staff responsible for reviewing the permit application. All timely filed comments will be considered by the staff prior to the final decision on the application. You will be added to the mailing list for this application. After the opportunity to submit comments ends, a copy of the formal written response to all timely filed comments will be mailed to you. If a decision is made to hold a public meeting, you will receive a hard copy of the public meeting notice in the mail.

All requests for hearings, if authorized by statute or rule, are considered by the Commissioners. The Commissioners will consider your request during a regularly scheduled Commission meeting that is open to the public, and a determination will be made as to whether the request will be granted. You will be notified in writing when your request is scheduled for consideration. If your request is granted, the matter will be referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH). The SOAH hearing will be a formal, legal proceeding, conducted in a manner like civil trials in state district court. While not required, parties are usually represented by legal counsel. For an issue to be considered at a contested case hearing, it must have been first raised in a comment or in a request for a contested case hearing during the public comment period by the affected person or group requesting the hearing.
