WQ0016171001, TO AUTHORIZE THE DISCHARGE OF TREATED DOMESTIC WASTEWATER AT AN ANNUAL AVERAGE FLOW NOT TO EXCEED 1,000,000 GALLONS PER DAY AND EXPRESSING CONCERNS REGARDING PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE IMPLICATIONS OF THE PROPOSED PERMIT.

CITY OF GREY FOREST WATER SYSTEM

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-43R

Expressing Opposition to Permit No. WQ0016171001

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WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Grey Forest ("City Council") and Grey Forest Water System finds it to be in the public interest, and necessary for the public health, safety and welfare to voice the collective concerns of the public regarding potential nuisances and proposed uses that are incompatible with surrounding uses and sound regional planning; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Operations is seeking to discharge effluent water into the Helotes Creek, at an annual average flow not to exceed 1,000,000 gallons a day; and

WHEREAS, the property designated as the site of the proposed development is located in the close proximity of the City of Grey Forest; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Operations, applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") for an Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES), which, if approved, would authorize discharge of treated domestic wastewater at an annual average flow not to exceed 1,000,000 gallons per day into Helotes Creek, thence to Culebra Creek, thence to Lower Leon Creek in Segment No. 1906 of the San Antonio River Basin; and

WHEREAS, concerned parties have until May 9, 2023 to submit comments and concerns to TCEQ in an effort to prompt the agency to hold a contested case hearing on the permit application; and


WHEREAS, concerned parties are encouraged to submit comments about the permit application to: Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, Office of the Chief Clerk, MC-1055, Post Office Box 13087, Austin, Texas, 78711-3087, or electronically at www.tceq.texas.gov/goto/comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council as the owner of Grey Forest Water System is concerned about the potential health and safety risks proposed by the effluent wastewater into the creeks and river for both nearby residents, business owners, natural habitat, and wildlife, and the implications for future residential developments in the surrounding area; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Grey Forest City Council:


1. The City Council, owner of Grey Forest Water System, hereby expresses its opposition to Permit No. WQ0016171001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at an annual average flow not to exceed 1,000,000 gallons per day.
2. The City Council hereby requests that the TCEQ deny Municipal Operations Permit No. WQ0016171001.
3. City Council authorizes the Mayor, on behalf of the City, to submit this Resolution, including additional comments by the Mayor attached hereto as Exhibit "A," to the TCEQ during the Formal Comment Period for the pending permit referenced herein.
4. The meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.
