You can read your public comment in court OR you can email it in and it will be read by a court official--either way **[we want you there with us!](#)**

If you want to [email your comment](#):

- Send your public comments to: **publiccomments@hayscountytexas.gov**
- They must be able to be read within 3 minutes.
- Emails must be received by 11:59 PM Monday June 8--but don't wait until the last minute!
- Your email must include the following REQUIRED information:
 - Name
 - Address
 - Phone number
 - The agenda item number: K.13

If you want to [read your 3 minute comment](#) to the court:

- Don't send your comment via email.
- Make sure you arrive before 9am to submit the public comment form.
- You can fill it out onsite or [print the form](#) and bring it with you. Either way, have it ready to turn in before 9am!
